

Deduct Meter Process

The Warwick Sewer Authority bases its sewer usage charges on water consumption at the property. If your property has a significant amount of water that is regularly NOT returned to the sewer system for treatment, it may be worth getting a deduct meter. Examples of such water usage may be landscape irrigation, swimming pool, or water used in manufacturing goods or products (such as baking, ice, or washing water).

Customers that use water that is not discharged to the sewer system may request to have a “deduct” meter installed to define the amount of water not discharged to the sewer system.

1. **Kent County Water Authority** customers must purchase a deduct meter from the **Warwick Sewer Authority**, 125 Arthur W. Devine Blvd., Warwick (401/739-4949).
2. **Warwick Water Division** customers must purchase a deduct meter from the **Warwick Water Division** located at 935 Sandy Lane, Warwick (401/738-2008).
3. 5/8” meters are kept in stock- all other sizes must be ordered.
 - a. WSA recommends having a plumber check the size needed before purchase.
 - i. Once the meter is purchased, no returns or exchanges are allowed.
4. The property owner must call for an **inspection** when the Deduct Meter is installed.
 - a. Inspections are conducted on Thursdays.
 - b. Deduction will not begin until Inspection is completed.**
